City of Vincent has developed the Mural Co-Funding Program to facilitate the commissioning of public murals by professional and emerging mural artists, enhancing our public places whilst also supporting local artists.

For the purpose of the Mural Co-Funding Program, a public mural is defined as a painting that is applied to a surface (wall, floor, soffit, permanent seating/tables can be considered) that is highly visible from the public realm and designed by an artist. Murals are expected to remain in situ for a minimum of four years.

Assessment Criteria

CONCEPT AND CONTEXT (40%)

- Strength, originality and quality of the mural design concept.
- Creative response to site and consideration of historic, cultural, architectural and geographical context.

LOCATION AND INTEGRATION (30%)

- Appropriateness of scale and consideration of surrounding environment.
- Enhancement of public realm and local identity.

FEASIBILITY (30%)

- Demonstrated ability of artist to complete the proposed mural project.

- Proposed management of ongoing maintenance of the mural (application of anti-graffiti coating preferred where possible).
